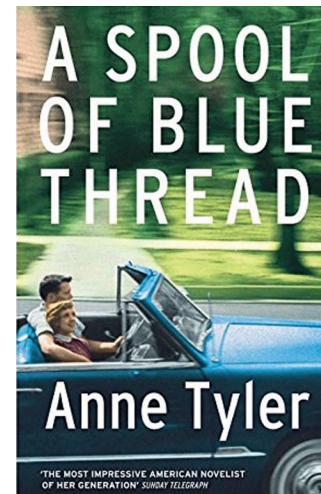
### Second Life
